## 2012 Florida SeniorFest Now in 6 Locations

Florida SeniorFest is expanding to six sites across the state and will take place February 13-18, 2012. Each of these spirit-filled, enlightening and faith deepening events will feature keynote presentations and workshops, plus uplifting music and worship.

**Dr. David Rhoads**, retired professor at Lutheran School of Theology in Chicago, will give a meaningful, dramatic presentation of New Testament scripture that brings new perspective to well-known verses. Dr. Rhoads describes "Performing the Story" as an authentic method, in keeping with the way scripture would have originally been presented.

**Mark Schoepp** of Wheat Ridge Ministries will speak about brain research and how three things - exercise, diet and play - profoundly affect the brain and can positively impact our ability to give God our best well into our senior years. He'll also present a workshop on how the brain wires and re-wires itself all throughout life, and how we can use that information to function more fully and understand ourselves, our children and even our grandchildren better.

**David Ludwig, Jr.**, will lead us in inspiring music and worship. Trained in both theology and music, he has served as music minister in ELCA and LCMS congregations, and has been a worship and workshop leader for numerous national and local events.
